
## ELECTRONIC EDITIONS OF SERBIAN ASTRONOMICAL INSTITUTIONS AND SOCIETIES 2013-2015

**Abstract**. Electronic publishing of astronomical institutions and societies from Serbia in the second part of 2013 and 2015 is described and analysed.


Keywords. Astronomy, electronic publishing.

The electronic publishing in astronomical institutions and societies in Serbia, which started in 2006, has been reviewed in detail in Ref. [1]. This activity within the 2006-2009 period was reviewed in detail in Ref. [1], for 2010 and the first part of 2011 in Ref. [2], in Ref. [3] for the second part of 2011 and the first part of 2012 and in Ref. [4] for the second part of 2012 and first part of 2013. In Refs. [1-4], has been presented 38 CDs and DVDs, published from 2006 up to the end of 2013. The publishers were Astronomical Observatory, Astronomical Society "Ruđer Bošković", Society of Astronomers of Serbia and Naturalist Society "GEA" from Vršac. One DVD, containing Abstracts, Presentations and Photos of the 1st Workshop "Astrophysical winds and disks; Similar phenomena in stars and quasars", organized 2009 in Platamonas, Greece, by Teams of National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (Faculty of Physics) and Astronomical Observatory of Belgrade, has been published in Greece. 
